8. Were you satisfied with each character's fate? Is there anyone you wish had a different ending?
9. Fast forward another eleven years from the end of *The Perfect Divorce*. What do you think Sarah Morgan is doing?
10. Imagine *The Perfect Divorce* as a film or television series—who would you cast as Sarah, Bob, and Adam?
